How should I pray?

Pray that God’s Shalom will fill the hearts and minds of all peoples in the region, bringing an end to terror and the shedding of innocent blood. Psalm 122 and Isaiah 62 teach us to “pray for the peace of Jerusalem” and “give Him no rest until He establishes Jerusalem as a praise in the earth.” Our prayers for Jerusalem should be regular and persistent.

For whom should I pray?

Pray for both Jew and Arab alike, and for all the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Specifically pray for religious and political leaders, oppressed women and children, victims of terror, believers in the Land, and the young generation of Israelis and Arab Palestinians.

How often should I pray?

Pray without ceasing. Make sure your local congregation is participating in the annual “Day of Prayer for the Peace of Jerusalem.” In addition, you are encouraged to make praying for the peace of Jerusalem a part of your daily prayers.
