**Read what happens**  
**Judges 8:15-17**

**Was it a good idea to be selfish with Israel over bread?**

Nabal refused to give David and his troops food. His foolish behavior caused his wife Abigail to provide the needed relief. Nabal's selfish lifestyle was known by everyone.

**Read what happens**  
**1 Samuel 25: 36-38**

**Was Nabal's life blessed or cursed?**

**Judges 3:16-25**
