

Marshmallow Wall with Watchmen

Materials Needed:

- 6 large marshmallows per child
- 1 can of cake frosting
- 1 Craft sticks or plastic knives for each child
- 1 large paper plate for each child
- 3 Gummy bears for each child
- A roll of waxed paper cut into 6" x 6" squares
- Plastic wrap - optional (to be used if children will take the walls home)
- Tape - optional (to be used if children will take the walls home)
- Marker - optional (to be used if children will take the walls home)

Talk about how each person does their part to guard their little section of the wall by praying for their part of the wall. Tell the children that they will get to make a wall that they can eat!

1. Give each child a paper plate with their name written on the top of the plate, a plastic knife or a craft stick and approximately 3 tablespoons of icing on the waxed paper.
2. Distribute eight marshmallows and for gummy bears to each child.
3. The children will liberally coat the top (the flat side) and side of one marshmallow with icing.
4. Then they will put a marshmallow on top (flat side to flat side) and next to the first marshmallow.
5. Continue building the wall in this manner until the wall is three marshmallows across and two marshmallows high.
6. Next, apply a glob of icing to the top of each row of two marshmallows. Stick a gummy bear on top of each marshmallow.

Enjoy them or lay the walls down to wrap the paper plate with plastic wrap to transport home with the children.
